

Star Struck 2023 Round 1 Vocal Audition Information

Nominations are now open for student singers interested in applying for a vocal role in Star Struck 2023. Vocal roles include: featured vocalists, backing vocalists, and the core choir.

Please read the following information carefully: Round 1 is a live audition. Auditions will be held on Friday 4 and Saturday 5 of November 2022 as well as on Thursday 3 November 2022 if an extra day is needed. Auditions will be held at Belmont Public School, 6 Livingstone Street, Belmont, NSW 2280 Anyone who wishes to be considered for Star Struck 2023 as a singer must complete an online application. For anyone who did not participate in Star Struck 2022 as a featured vocalist or backing vocalist you must complete the form titled Star Struck 2023 Vocal Auditions Round 1 Please note anyone who participated in the 2022 core choir is required to audition in round 1 and therefore needs to Round 1 complete the Star Struck 2023 Vocal Auditions Round 1 form. If you were a featured vocalist or backing vocalist in 2022 please complete the form titled Star Struck 2023 Returning Artists Vocal Auditions Returning artists do not need to participate in Round 1 and will instead be invited directly to Round 2 which is scheduled to be held on Friday 2 and Saturday 3 December 2022. Round 2 information will be sent out after the completion of Round 1 auditions. **Principal Permission** All students auditioning for Star Struck 2023 must have their principal's permission. Please ensure you inform them before you submit your application. Principals and schools will be notified of your submission. Round 1 and returning artist applications are due by Friday 21 October 2022. Applications are online and can be found Application via the links above. Due Date Your form must include your @education.nsw.gov.au student email address as this is the address audition times and results will be sent to. Please ensure this address is accurate - spelling, numbers after name, etc. Vocal auditions incur a fee of \$20. Anyone auditioning must pay this fee to their school by Friday 28 October 2022. Pavment Information Schools will be sent a journal for audition fees on Monday 31 October 2022. Students are required to prepare ONE song excerpt of 2 minutes maximum. The audition criteria is designed to address technical vocal ability as well as your performance presentation. • The excerpt does not necessarily have to begin from the start of the song. • You must sing with a backing track or live accompaniment. Acapella singing is not acceptable. • You must sing with the microphone and PA system provided. • The panel will fade your music out if your excerpt is longer than 2 minutes. Please do not sing along with the original artist on the track (backing vocals are acceptable). Audition • You must sing from memory. Do not read off of sheet music or a page of lyrics. Information Backing track format options: Bring your backing track on a USB stick saved as an MP3 file. We will have a laptop to play it from. • Save your backing track onto your smart phone, tablet, etc. We will be able to plug this into the PA system (do not try and stream music from YouTube or other online services as this quite often drops out or won't load). Please ensure you have a 3.5mm headphone output socket or adaptor cable for our auxiliary cord to plug into. We do not provide USB-C or Apple Lightning adaptors, etc. All vocal auditions are closed to parents, other students and members of the public. Only the auditioning student and Audition their accompanist (where applicable) should enter the audition room. The area immediately surrounding the audition regulations space should be clear of all people at all times. By your child attending the audition you are providing consent as per the statement below: I acknowledge that this event/activity is required to be held in accordance with any current NSW Health COVID-19 Parent Public Health Orders and the NSW Department of Education's policies and procedures. I acknowledge and accept that Consent there is a risk that my child may be exposed to COVID-19 whilst attending and participating at this event. I confirm that my child will not attend if displaying any symptoms of illness, and/or if directed to isolate under public health orders.

	Please keep in mind that the show you are auditioning for is large scale, high energy and very eclectic show with a wide audience demographic. All too often students perform pieces of music that aren't appropriate for Star Struck or don't give us enough scope to be able to hear you singing in a musical style that will ultimately be chosen for the show. When choosing your songs, do your research. Look at past Star Struck shows to see what style of songs have been performed and use this information to inform your choice.
