	Choirs are to audition with two songs, the National Anthem and an own choice song.				
	The National Anthem needs to be only one verse, and should be performed in the child-friendly				
	key of B-flat major. Accompaniment is strongly advised, you may wish to use an instrumental				
	track. This YouTube video is in the suggested key 'Australian National Anthem (Instrumental)'.				
Audition	Own choice songs should demonstrate the skills of your choir. Songs with two-part harmony are

	it is in the right pitch range for your students – not too low in pitch.
