Audition Information for Dance Groups

Applications are now open for schools to audition for a place in a mass dance item in Star Struck 2019.

Audition Applications due date: Wednesday 27 February 2019.

Please read the following information carefully as it outlines the expectations of auditions and participation:

Program information	Star Struck is an annual performing arts arena event for public schools from across the Hunter and Central Coast. It is an exciting showcase of dance, drama and music performed to a live orchestra by students from Kindergarten to Year 12 from a vast network of NSW public schools. 2019 will be the 27th year of Star Struck.

Associated fees	<p>The following costs are associated with participation in Star Struck dance items. All payments are due by Friday 12 April 2019. Final numbers for dance groups MUST be emailed to starstruck@det.nsw.edu.au by Friday 3 May 2019. Schools will be debited after this date as part of the monthly sundry tax upload system.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Participation Fee - \$30 per student No GSTSecurity Fee - \$5.50 per student including GSTEvent T-shirts - \$22 including GST each. Please note t-shirts are a requirement for all students in mass school dance and drama items as these will be used to form part of a costume in the 2019 show.

Selection	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Schools can nominate to be considered for one or two items. Individual school groups will not be allocated more than two items plus the finale. Whilst we do our best to accommodate school requests, only groups that score 17 or above will be offered a place in a second item.Please refer to the attached Audition Video Rubric for clear guidelines on your audition.
YouTube	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Audition videos are submitted through YouTube.Instructions on uploading to YouTube are attached.No other submission methods will be accepted.The students presented on your footage should be the group that will perform in Star Struck 2019.
Application Due Date	Auditions are to be submitted no later than Wednesday 27 February 2019 at 5pm

If successful at audition:

Teachers meeting	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Supervising teachers MUST attend the Teacher's Meeting on Tuesday 19 March 2019 from 4pm – 5.30pm at Hunter Theatre (Hunter School of Performing Arts, Cameron Street, Broadmeadow)										
Group numbers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Combined dance items involve a number of school groups, each group of which consists of 16 students or, for smaller schools, 8 students.Please ensure your school group adheres to the correct number of students as the choreography of all items is based on these numbers.										
Featured dance ensemble auditions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Ensemble auditions will occur at a later date, Sunday March 24 2019.Students must be a member of a school dance group to be eligible to audition for a place in the featured dance ensembles.Please note students in ensemble dances can perform in up to a maximum of four items only plus the finale.Featured artists – students successful in auditioning for a place in a featured dance ensemble will be required to pay a \$50 (No GST) participation fee. This will replace their \$30 (No GST, school group participation fee).										
Rehearsals	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Teachers are responsible for rehearsing set choreography after allocated rehearsals have occurred.We are unable to fulfill requests for specific dance rehearsal dates.
